VIRTUALCC AND CO-FOUNDER/CEO PAUL MIZZI FINISHES AMONG TOP 4 FINALISTS OF AMP FOUNDATION 'TOMORROW MAKERS' SPARK AWARD 2023 SHOWCASE

SYDNEY, DEC 6th 2023

VirtualCC Co-Founder/CEO, Paul Mizzi, has been awarded for his completion of the AMP Foundation's 'Tomorrow Makers' SPARK award, finishing among the top 4 finalists selected to pitch their social enterprise at the 2023 showcase event, held in the AMP offices at Quay Quarter Tower in Sydney on Dec 6th 2023. Paul's achievement of securing a position in the top four stemmed from a competitive pool of more than 800 applicants, including 13 awardees, all of whom successfully completed the 20-week course. SPARK is a new initiative delivered in collaboration with Impact Boom and the AMP Foundation Tomorrow Makers Program, designed to help social entrepreneurs grow their ideas and create positive social change.

Once fully operational, VirtualCC aims to directly address Workplace Ageism by providing remote, meaningful, permanent part-time employment to people aged over 50 living in Regional Australia. As a social enterprise, VirtualCC will employ Over 50's directly as WFH contact centre agents and provide training and resources to deliver contact centre services. The outsourced services will be delivered to businesses who want to utilise the depth of knowledge and skills of this often overlooked demographic. Through the SPARK initiative, Paul was able to host a VirtualCC Proof of Concept to great success.
